

STATEMENT REGARDING California's Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986 ("Proposition 65")

Fischer Connectors products are exempt from California's Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986, as they are only sub-products for industrial or professional use, and are not "Consumer products" as defined in the California Code of Regulations: "not produced, distributed, or sold for the personal use, consumption or enjoyment of a consumer."

Note that they may include components made with copper alloys, with lead (CASRN 7439-92-1), up to 4% by weight, and a surface coating including nickel (CASNR 7440-02-0), estimated up to 0.1% by weight. Lead and Nickel are substances listed in Proposition 65. For additional information about the presence of lead in our products, please refer to our [REACH compliance statement](#).

Because Fischer Connectors products are exempt from Proposition 65, warnings are not placed on them, on packaging or on website. Fischer Connectors customers putting final state products to the consumer market in California need to assess the need for warning labels.
